THE LEPERS ARE CLEANSED

LUKE 17:11-19

1. **Jesus is great!**

- He has **ALL authority** to heal **ALL** of these lepers **ALL** at once!

2. **Jesus is good!**

- These lepers ask for mercy and they receive it, because Jesus is a merciful Savior!
- Jesus will never cast aside anyone who comes to Him!

JOHN 6:35-40

And how much were they cleansed? "Katharós" -- without spot or mixture. They were completely healed!

The response of the one leper who comes back is humble gratitude.

- He worships Jesus with a loud voice (literally, 'megaphone').
- He falls on his face in worship.
- He gives thanks.

Note the significance of the fact that only one leper returns to worship Jesus, and he is a Samaritan. The rest are Jews.

The Spiritual Significance For Us

- God has healed us of our spiritual leprosy in Jesus Christ.

TITUS 2:11-14; 1 JOHN 1:5-9

- God has welcomed us -- who were spiritual foreigners -- into the household of God through His son, Jesus Christ!

JOHN 1:9-13; EPHESIANS 2:12-19

Our response should be the same as this leper when he was cleaned...

- Humbly bow before God with thanks and reverence **AND loudly proclaim** how great He is!

Then, with a megaphone, shout in our neighborhoods and to the ends of the earth how great our God is and how He has made Himself known to us in Jesus Christ!
