### Peter's Sermon At The Temple

- Points the people to Jesus as the \_\_\_\_\_. (v.11-12,16)
- Reminds the people of their \_\_\_\_\_. (v.13-15)
- Invites the people to \_\_\_\_\_ of their sin and \_\_\_\_\_ Christ! (v.17-21)
- Encourages them with the \_\_\_\_\_ of repentance. (v.19-21)

*“that your sins may be blotted out” -- Psalm 103:10-13*

*“that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord”*

*“that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus,<sup>21</sup> whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago.”*

- **Reminds the people of their sin. (v.13-15)**
- **Invites the people to repent of their sin and trust Christ! (v.17-21)**
- **Encourages them with the blessings of repentance. (v.19-21)**

*“that your sins may be blotted out” -- Psalm 103:10-13*

*“that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord”*

*“that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus,<sup>21</sup> whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago.”*
