  Men -- Be men of prayer & worship without <u>anger</u> or <u>quarreling</u> (v.8). Women -- Be <u>self-controlled</u>, not focusing on what you look like on the outside, but who you are on the <u>inside</u> (v.9-10).

## Women In The Church (v.11-14)

Since this is a passage that has been weaponized it is important to understand what it DOESN'T mean so we can clearly understand what it DOES mean.

• "Learn quietly" ≠ silent; "Submit" ≠ obey; "Teach or exercise authority over a man" ≠ able to teach

Teaching and exercising authority is talking specifically about serving as an Elder. (see 1 Timothy 3)
