Jesus gives us a model for how we ought to pray... (v.9-15)

- WORSHIP of the Father "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name."
- <u>SUBMISSION</u> to His Kingdom "Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."
- Make your <u>NEEDS</u> <u>KNOWN</u> to your Father "Give us this day our daily bread,"
- Ask the Father for <u>GRACE</u> as you <u>REPENT</u> of sin "and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors."
- Protection from <u>TEMPTATION</u> from the Father "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil"

3 Promises To Rest In When Praying:

- 1. As believers in Jesus, we have been INVITED into the PRESENCE of God!
- 2. God always HEARS and WELCOMES us!
- 3. Be confident that <u>EVERY TIME</u> you come to Him you will receive <u>MERCY</u> and find <u>GRACE</u> to help in your time of need! *Hebrews 4:14-16*

- TRUST in God's unwavering love for you.
- REJOICE in the God of your salvation.
- SING to the Lord that has dealt generously with you.
