

## GOD OF GRACE, GLORY & WRATH

HEBREWS 10:26-39

<sup>26</sup> For if we go on sinning deliberately after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, <sup>27</sup> but a fearful expectation of judgment, and a fury of fire that will consume the adversaries. <sup>28</sup> Anyone who has set aside the law of Moses dies without mercy on the evidence of two or three witnesses. <sup>29</sup> How much worse punishment, do you think, will be deserved by the one who has trampled underfoot the Son of God, and has profaned the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has outraged the Spirit of grace? <sup>30</sup> For we know him who said, “Vengeance is mine; I will repay.” And again, “The Lord will judge his people.” <sup>31</sup> It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. <sup>32</sup> But recall the former days when, after you were enlightened, you endured a hard struggle with sufferings, <sup>33</sup> sometimes being publicly exposed to reproach and affliction, and sometimes being partners with those so treated. <sup>34</sup> For you had compassion on those in prison, and you joyfully accepted the plundering of your property, since you knew that you yourselves had a better possession and an abiding one. <sup>35</sup> Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward. <sup>36</sup> For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. <sup>37</sup> For, “Yet a little while, and the coming one will come and will not delay; <sup>38</sup> but my righteous one shall live by faith, and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him.” <sup>39</sup> But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who have faith and preserve their souls.

### Grace & Wrath

- **Our God is a God of \_\_\_\_\_ but He is also a God of \_\_\_\_\_.**

*Understanding God’s hatred of sin and the wrath that He will bring because of it helps us see more clearly the intricate beauty of the grace He has provided through Jesus!*

- **A harsh warning about wrath & judgment... Do not become \_\_\_\_\_ to the wrath of God towards sin!**

HEBREWS 2:2-3 <sup>2</sup> For since the message declared by angels proved to be reliable, and every transgression or disobedience received a just retribution, <sup>3</sup> how shall we escape if we neglect such a great salvation?

HEBREWS 3:11-13 <sup>11</sup> “As I swore in my wrath, ‘They shall not enter my rest.’” <sup>12</sup> Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. <sup>13</sup> But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called “today,” that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

*v.26-27 - A harsh picture of judgment.*

*v.28-29 - There is a punishment that is worse than death.*

*v.30-31 - It is fearful to face the judgment of a living, holy God, and that is exactly where we will find ourselves apart from Christ.*

- Where there is no longer a \_\_\_\_\_ for sin, there is a \_\_\_\_\_ full of terrifying wrath towards sin.
- The \_\_\_\_ of God provides escape from the \_\_\_\_ of God by the sacrifice of the \_\_\_\_ of God!
- So, in essence, we are saved...

## So What?

*When we rightfully know the wrath of a holy God towards sin and then remember the grace of God expressed to us in Jesus, it should continually be a reminder that God has made a way for me to know Him and be with Him.*

*Then, as I look forward in my life, it should remind me that I can trust Him to see me through until the end!*

- **When we have hard times and persecution in this life it can and should lead us toward a deeper \_\_\_\_\_ on God, and not away from Him. (v.32-39)**
- **Difficulty in this life is a reminder that this world is not \_\_\_\_\_. It is a reminder that God has something \_\_\_\_\_ waiting for those who trust Him.**

*Continue trusting Christ. Continue following Him. Because the reward of your hope is greater than the struggles of this life!*

2 CORINTHIANS 4:16-18 <sup>16</sup> So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. <sup>17</sup> For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, <sup>18</sup> as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.

ROMANS 8:31-39 <sup>31</sup> What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup> He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? <sup>33</sup> Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. <sup>34</sup> Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. <sup>35</sup> Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? <sup>36</sup> As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." <sup>37</sup> No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. <sup>38</sup> For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, <sup>39</sup> nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

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  - From God's wrath.
  - By God's grace.
  - For God's glory.
