GALATIANS 2:11-21

1. Paul calls out Peter's HYPOCRISY. (v.11-14)

- Hypocrisy UNDERMINES our Gospel UNITY.
- Healthy COMMUNITY allows for loving CONFRONTATION.

Only listen to criticism from people you would take advice from.

2. We are JUSTIFIED by faith in Christ, not by WORKS! (v.15-16)

- Justified = declared RIGHTEOUS, even though we are GUILTY.
- The law has the ability to SHOW us our sin, but not the ability to SAVE us.

HEBREWS 10:1-4, 11:14

3. CRUCIFIED with Christ and ALIVE in Him! (v.17-20)

- *Our old self (self-reliant, proud, me-centered identity) was executed on the cross with Jesus!*
- Now my IDENTITY isn't found in anything in this world. It is found in CHRIST!

4. Be careful that we don't SET ASIDE the Gospel for something else. If we could be righteous any other way, then Jesus died for NOTHING! (v.21)
