There's a difference between the Law that directs us and the promise that drives us. And we can see his point by looking at three things the Law *can't* do.

- The Law can't FINISH what faith STARTED. (v.1-5)
- The Law can't GIVE what only God PROMISED. (v.6-9)
- The Law can't CURSE what Christ has CURED. (v.10-14)
