PSALM 139

1. God knows you COMPLETELY. (vv.1–6)

- God knows you completely and STILL LOVES YOU!
- He knows EVERYWHERE you go, EVERY THOUGHT you think and EVERY WORD before it is spoken. *Psalms 44:20-21*
- This knowledge is too wonderful for us. We cannot WRAP OUR MINDS around it.

2. God is ALWAYS with you. (vv.7–12)

- There's NOWHERE you can go that God isn't ALREADY there.
- You cannot escape His SPIRIT or His PRESENCE. *Jeremiah 23:23–24*
- Heaven, Sheol, the far side of the sea, or the darkest night... He is there. And DARKNESS IS LIKE LIGHT to Him.
- His hand leads you and holds you even when you feel FURTHEST AWAY. *Is. 49:15-16*

3. God formed you with PURPOSE. (vv.13–18)

- Your existence is not ACCIDENTAL. You were INTENTIONALLY made by God.
- God KNIT YOU TOGETHER in your mother's womb. *Jeremiah 1:5*
- You are FEARFULLY and WONDERFULLY made.
- All your days were WRITTEN IN HIS BOOK before one of them came to be.

4. God invites our SURRENDER. (vv.19–24)

- The right response to knowing that we are fully known and fully loved by God is to INVITE GOD to keep SEARCHING us and keep leading us.
