Gospel Principle: God's salvation brings <u>liberation</u> from our bondage to sin. *God sets us free. GALATIANS 4:4-7* 

3. "I will redeem you with an outstretched arm."

Gospel Principle: It is God who <u>redeems us</u> through His work and His power. *God buys us back. EPHESIANS 1:7-10* 

- 4. "I will take you to be my people."
- 5. "I will be your God."

Gospel Principle: God makes us His own, <u>adopting us</u> into His family. *God loves us. JOHN 1:12-13* 

- 6. "I will bring you into the land that I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and to Jacob."

Gospel Principle: There is an <u>inheritance waiting</u> for those who trust and follow God. God keeps His promises and blesses His people. EPHESIANS 1:11-14
