Applying God's Truth To Worship (v.22-26)

- **God expects purity and modesty from us when we come to worship Him. (v.26)**
- **Worshipping God isn't confined to a specific place... We can worship Him in Spirit and Truth anywhere! (v.24)**

Applying God's Truth To How We Treat Others (v.1-11)

- **God expects us to treat those who work for us with dignity and fairness, not harshly.**
- **Even though arranged marriages were common in these days, God expects women - who bear His image and are equal in dignity and worth in His eyes - to be treated with love, dignity and respect!**

Applying God's Truth With Justice & Mercy (v.12-32)

- **God gives life and God values life. As image bearers of God, we must uphold the sanctity of life. There is justice and punishment awaiting those who do not value life the way God does.**
- **However, the punishment must be just and equal. There must be mercy and fairness in the way we handle things.**
