- Blessed = happy, fortunate, blissful, content.
 - Jesus' route to happiness is the only way to true happiness... But it's a much different route than the world will take you!
 - Because external things cannot satisfy internal needs!
 - Happiness in God's Kingdom is both present and future.
1. Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.
 - This is the opposite of self-sufficiency.
 - We come to Christ for salvation bringing nothing, yet gaining everything!
 2. Blessed are you who are hungry now, for you shall be satisfied.
 - The key is to keep on hungering.
 3. Blessed are you who weep now, for you shall laugh.
 - There is comfort now. (PS 34:18)... There will be comfort forever! (REV 21:4)
 4. Blessed are you when people hate you and when they exclude you and revile you and spurn your name as evil, on account of the Son of Man!
