WEEK OF MARCH 22

GOSPEL HOPE FOR DUMMIES – LUKE 22:1-38

DAY 1 (LUKE 22:1-6)

Read The Passage

Discuss

The leaders are working with Judas (one of Jesus' disciples) to betray Him. They've been looking for the right opportunity, and now they have it because Judas is willing to help them trap Jesus.

- *Why do you think Judas is willing to betray Jesus? (see v.3 & Matthew 26:15).*
- *Have you ever been hurt deeply by a friend? How does it make you feel to know one of Jesus' closest friends was willing to hurt Him?*

Pray

Pray God would help us love Jesus more than anything. More than friends, more than money, more than stuff, and that we'd never want to give Jesus up for anything else.

DAY 2 (LUKE 22:7-23)

Read The Passage

Discuss

One of the last things Jesus does with His friends before He goes to the cross is to have a meal with them. This meal is called The Lord's Supper (sometimes we call it 'communion'), and we celebrate this meal regularly with our church family. Jesus gave His friends and us this meal so that we could remember that He died for us and tell each other why this is actually good news.

- *Do you like sitting down to eat with your family and/or special friends? Why?*
- *How does eating the Lord's Supper help you remember what Jesus did for you?*

Pray

Thank God that He has given us a meal to remember Jesus' death for us. Pray that we would remember Jesus' sacrifice for us often and that it would cause us to love Him more.

DAY 3 (LUKE 22:24-30)

Read The Passage

Discuss

Even after Jesus has given them an important meal and warned them that somebody close to them would betray him, the disciples still seemed to only be concerned with themselves. Instead of thinking of Jesus, they are more worried about which one of them is the best. They should have been focused on Jesus, but instead they were focused on themselves. Jesus uses this as an opportunity to teach them that the best of people are always the ones who care about serving others.

- *Can you think of a time someone has done something special to take care of you?*
- *How did it make you feel to know you were cared for?*
- *What are some ways you can care for people around you?*
- *What has Jesus done to care for your needs?*
- *Why is it amazing that Jesus Himself is the one who meets our most important needs?*

Pray

Thank God that He cares about you. Tell Him why you're thankful. Ask Him to help you care about others like He's cared about you.

DAY 4 (LUKE 22:31-38)

Read The Passage

Discuss

The leaders are working with Judas (one of Jesus' disciples) to betray Him. They've been looking for the right opportunity, and now they have it because Judas is willing to help them trap Jesus.

- *A few days ago (day 1) we asked if anyone had ever hurt you. But have *you* ever hurt someone you loved?*
- *Peter committed a horrible sin against Jesus. He turned his back on Him. Do you think Jesus loved Peter less because of that?*
- *Why is it amazing that even though Jesus knew Peter would betray Him, He still prayed for Peter?*

Pray

Pray that God would help you see where you sin and that He would forgive you. Thank God for forgiving you. Ask Him to help you be strong as you try to follow and obey Him.
